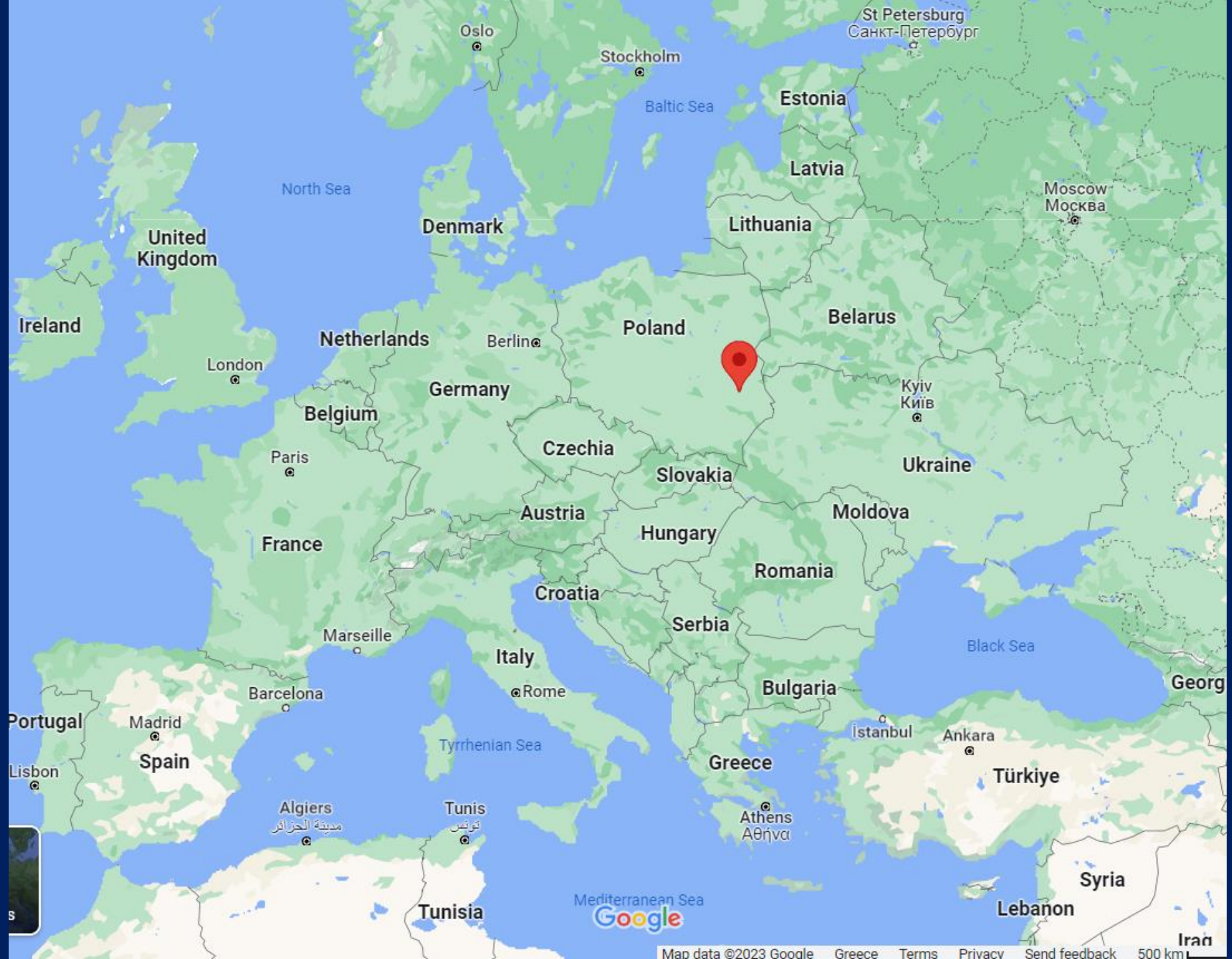


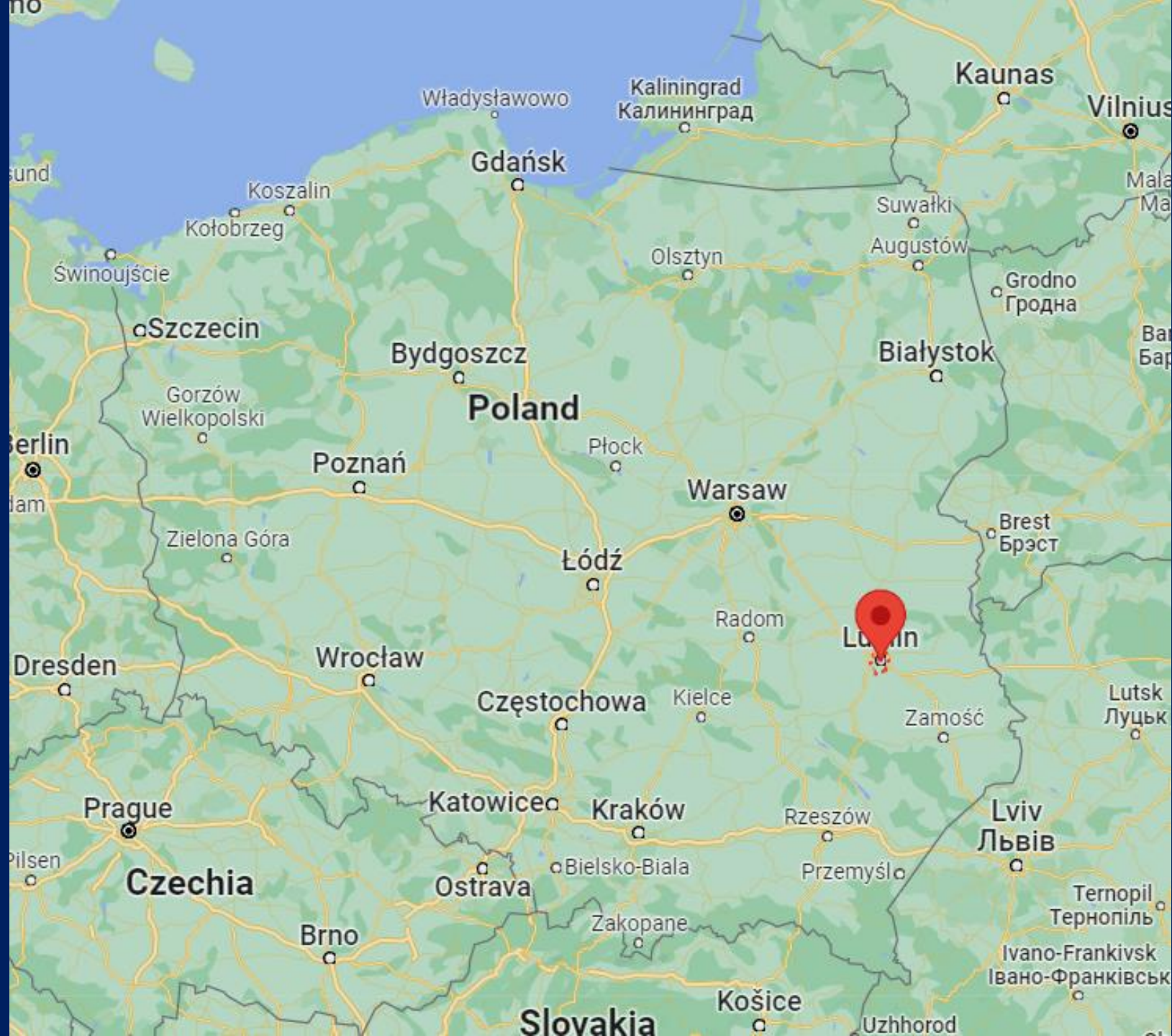

A multinational team whose goal is to implement tasks related to the adaptation and integration of international students into the UMCS culture and family.

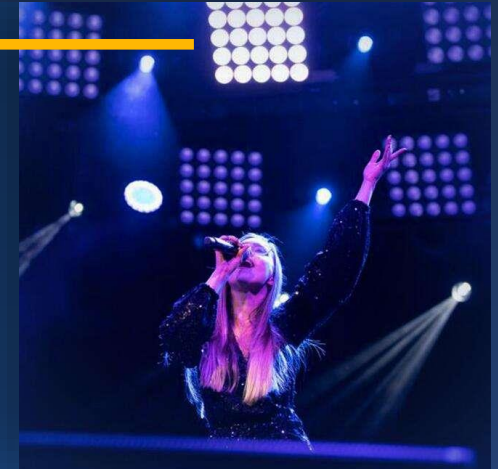


The UMCS Botanical Garden

Established in 1965. The main task of this scientific-didactic unit is the active protection of 7000 endangered species of plants. A garden is also a place of leisure and recreation.

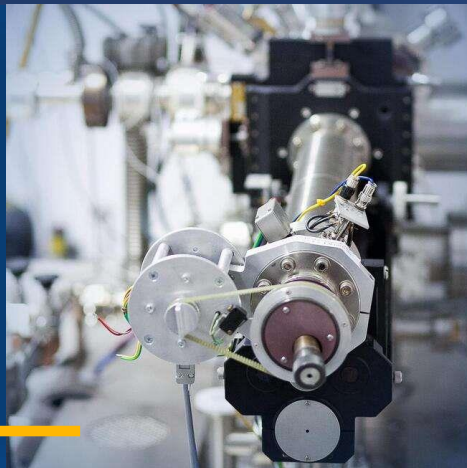
Academic Centre of Culture and Media UMCS Chatka
