




 Doctoral School of Humanities and Art: archaeology, philosophy, history,


linguistics, literary studies, culture and religion studies, fine arts and art conservation, music

15 UMCS scientists are included in the top 2% list, the prestigious ranking of the world's most influential people of science. The top 2% list contains the names of scientists from around the world whose publications are most often cited by other authors.

UMCS researchers publish on average 2 500 publications per year.
