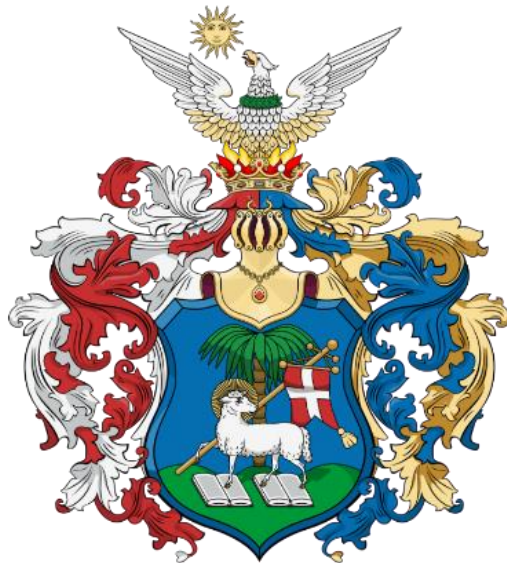


Debrecen - Location of the second largest city in Hungary

The University of Debrecen has an uninterrupted history reaching back almost 500 years.

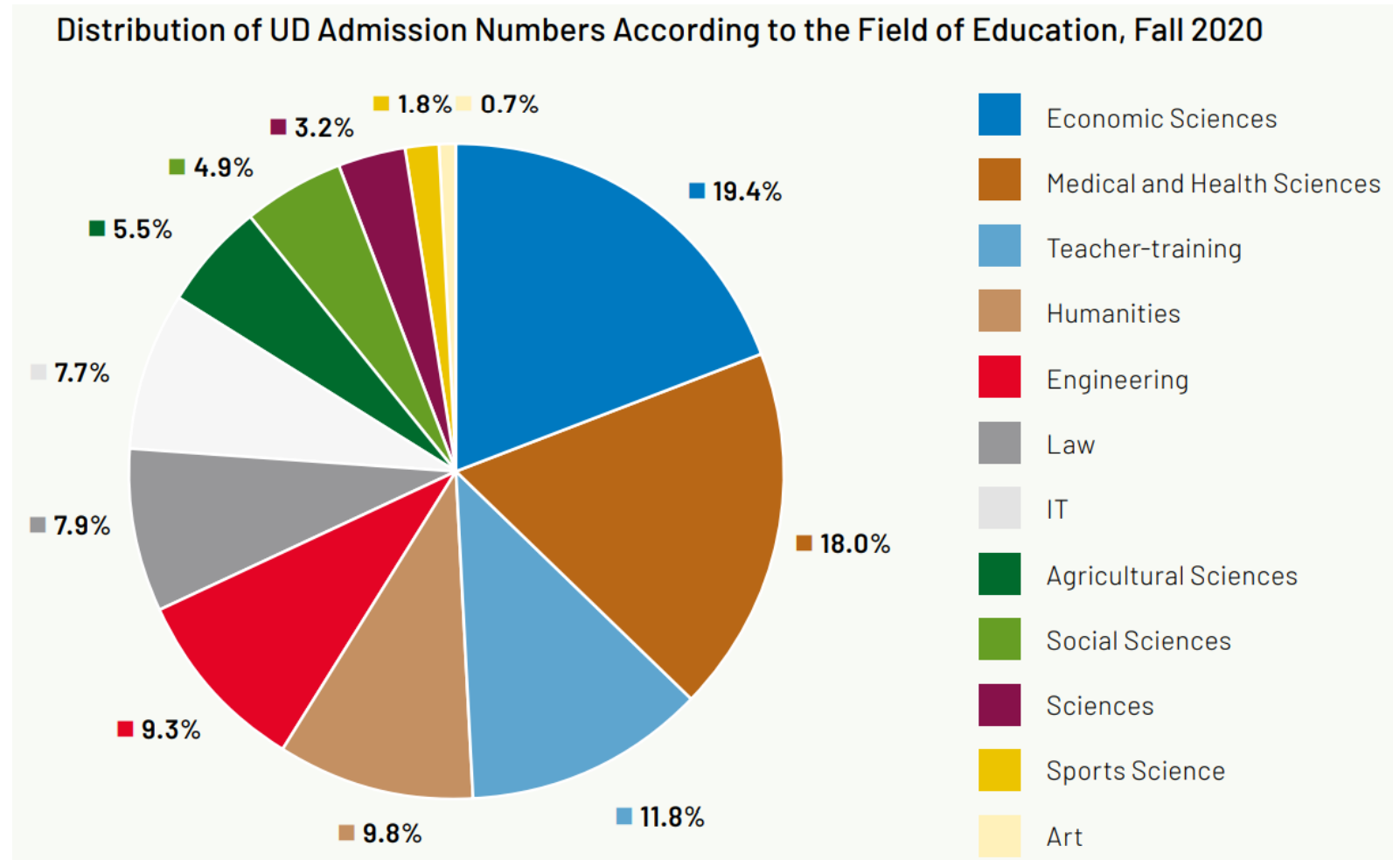
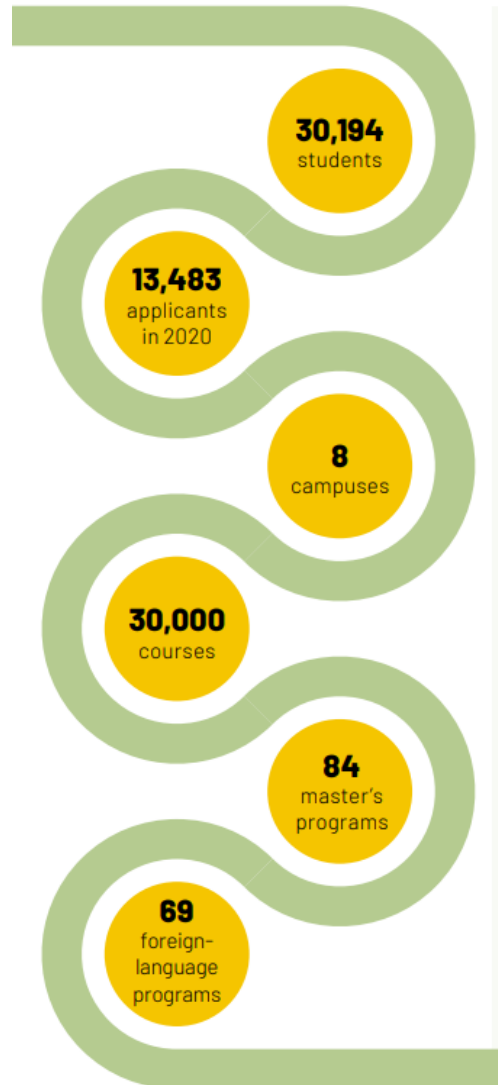
It is one of the oldest higher education institutions in Hungary.

The current form of the University of Debrecen was created in 2000, when several former independent universities merged.

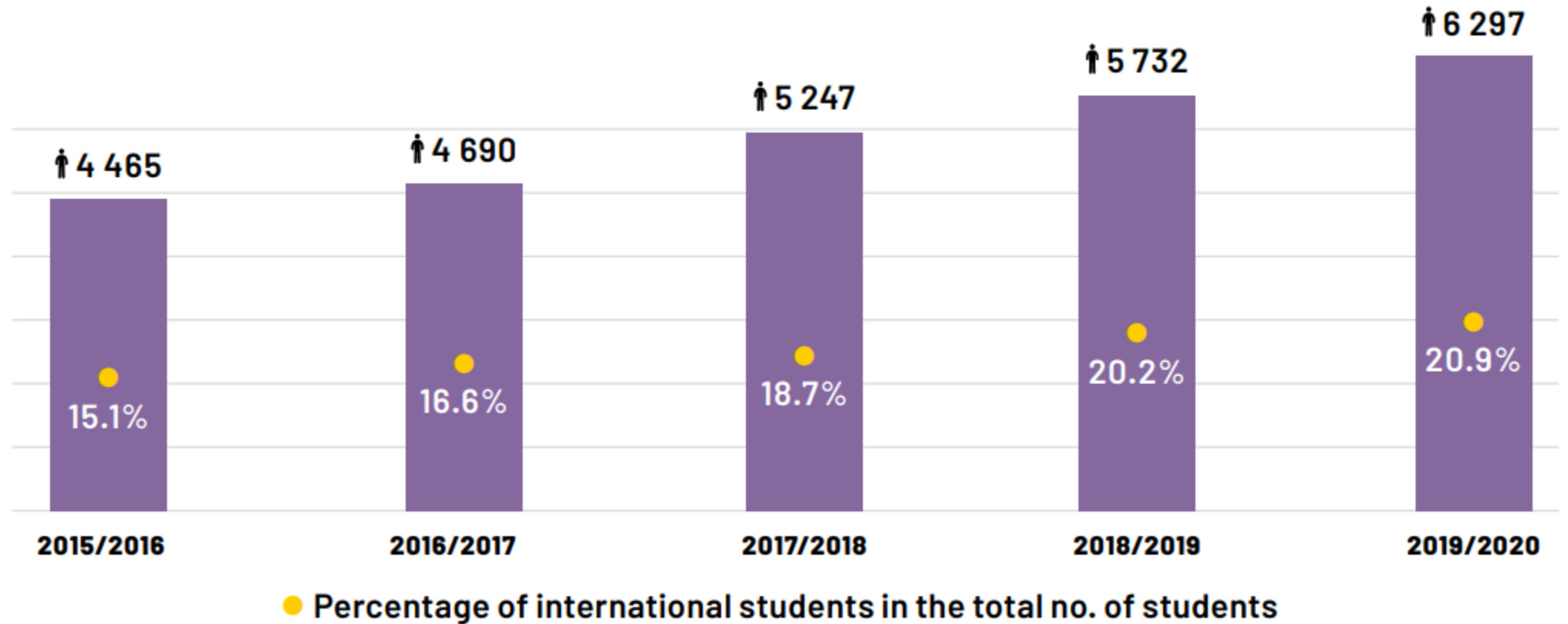

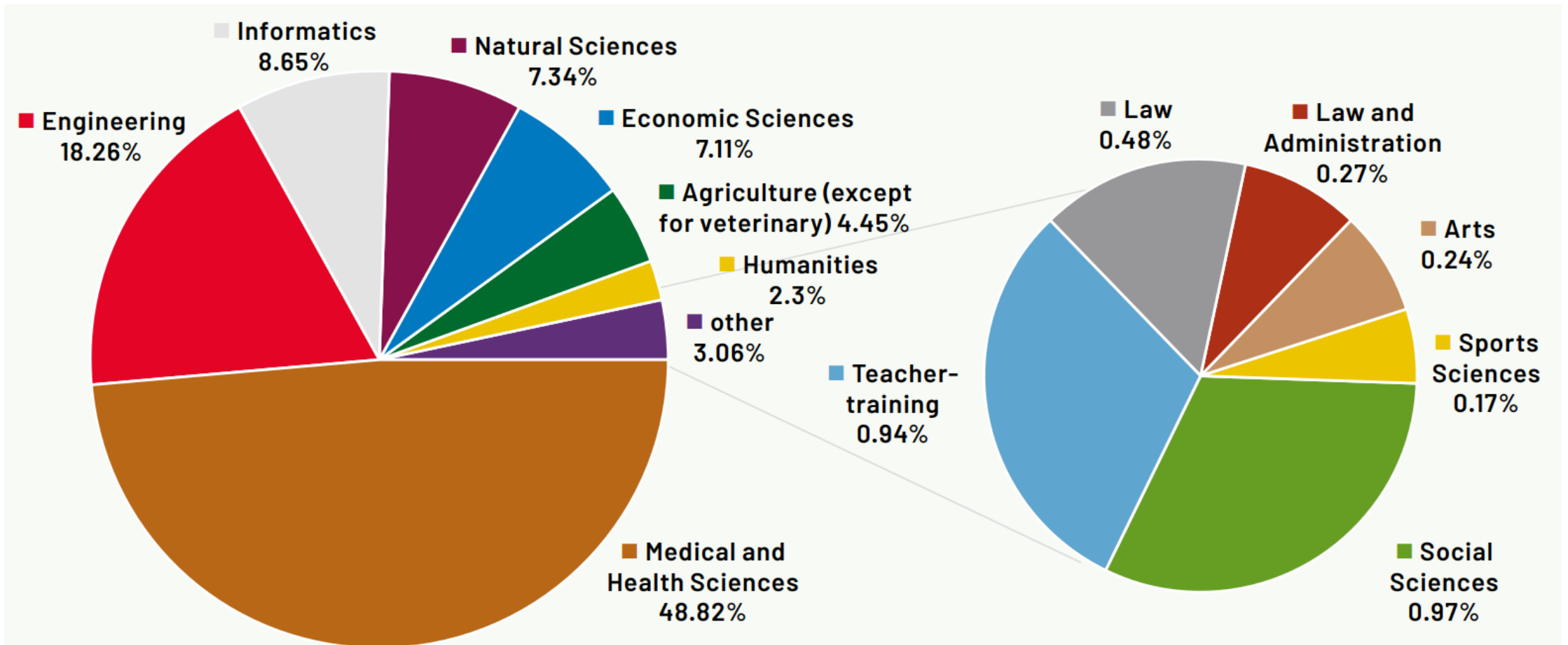

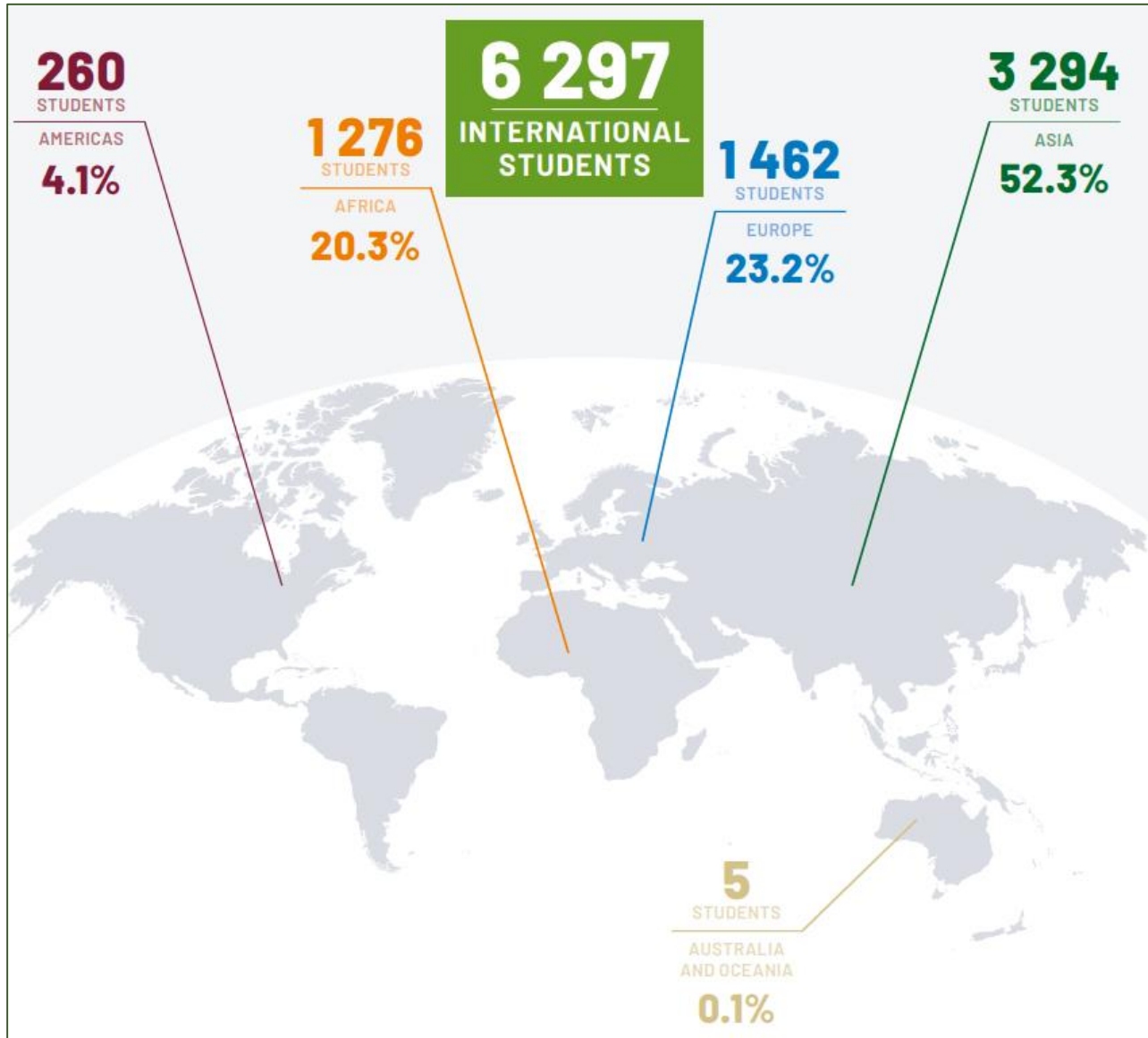
Number of UD International Students 2015-2020



Distribution of UD International Students According to Disciplines, 2019/2020

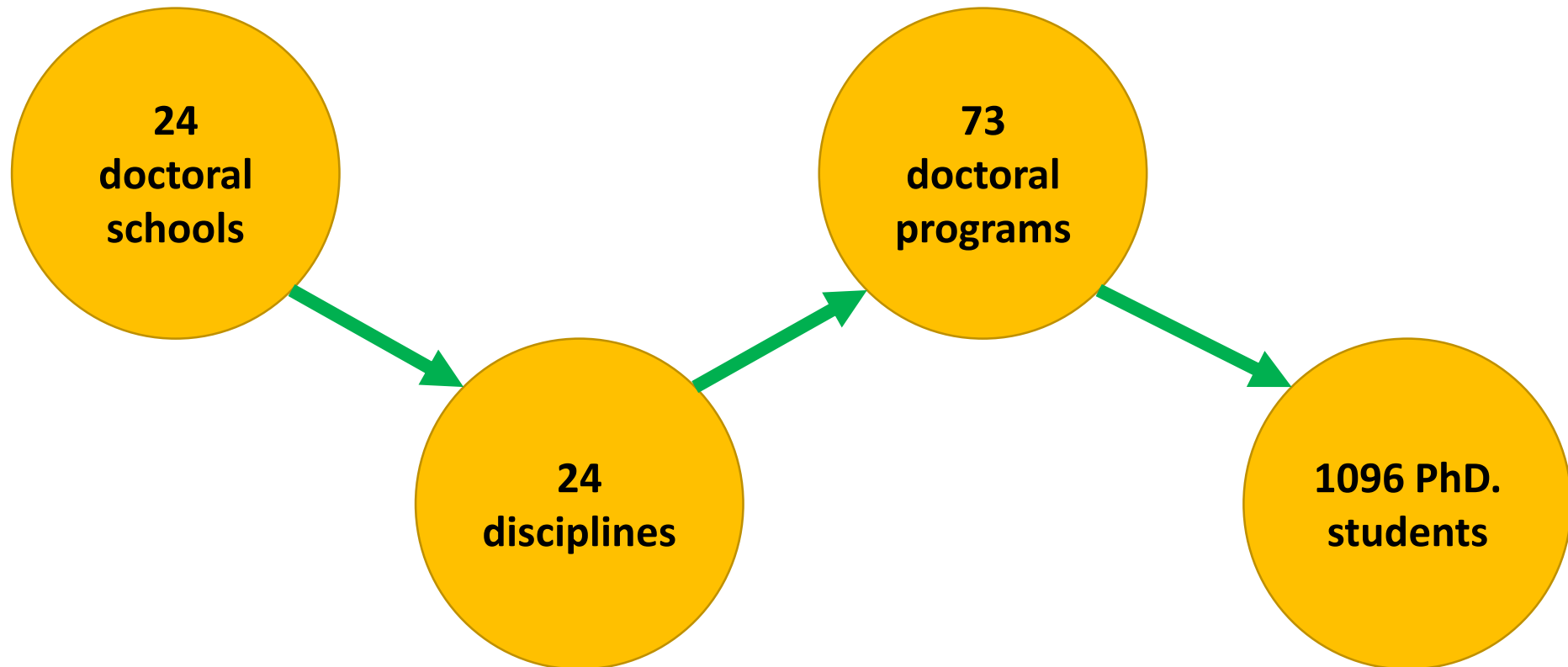


International students' home continents
