The University of Debrecen has an uninterrupted history reaching back almost 500 years.


It is one of the oldest higher education institution in Hungary.

The current form of the University of Debrecen was created in 2000, when several former independent universities merged.






Number of UD International Students 2015-2020




Percentage of international students in the total no. of students

International students ' home continents




In addition to bachelor's and master's courses, it is also possible to study for a PhD at the University of Debrecen.







