
The capital city of Prishtina



Some facts about Kosova

- Albanians sum up for around 90% of Kosova's population, Serbs being the second largest ethnic group in the country, followed by Bosniaks, Gorani, Roma, Turks, Ashkali and Egyptians.
- Muslim, catholic and orthodox Christians are the three major religious groups.
- The official languages of the country :Albanian,
 Serbian, English, with several others in municipalities.
- More than half of the population is under 25, adding up to the problem of unemployment in the country.

The HE in Kosovo

- the University of Prishtina was the first HEI established in Kosovo in 1969
- The HE system in the country operates through 7 public universities and approximately 20 private HEI-s
- Education is delivered in Albanian, Serbian,

Bosnian, Turkish, and English

- Each year about 25.000 students complete secondary education
- About 20.000 aim to continue HE each year

Prishtina International Summer University

Prishtina International Summer University provides a unique opportunity for participating students to expand their knowledge and skills in different fields of study. In April 1999 representatives of University of Prishtina and Academic Association started their discussions about possibilities of organizing International Summer University in Prishtina. The first International Summer University was organized in summer 2001. The first edition of Prishtina Summer University had a great success as it established international contacts and provided the infrastructure for the future editions of PISU. In the year 2002 University of Prishtina renamed the Summer University as Prishtina Summer University.

As a result of the proven success, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the government of Holland rewarded the project with financial support for the next editions of PISU. More than 4000 local, regional and international students and more than 400 local and international professors participated in the PISU. Prishtina Summer University has achieved proven values and provided a beginning for regional reconciliation and cooperation among different communities and academics from the region.

The Vision


• **Our vision** is to develop a school in accordance with standards and the most advanced teaching and learning methods, in a two-week period (10 working days)

PISU believes that all students should have access to multidisciplinary summer teaching programs that help to enrich and supplement the knowledge and skills acquired during the regular studies, as well as to encourage academic achievement and development.

• This summer school will provide new programs that actively engage students and professors, by making the summer program an essential component of all effort of promoting cooperation and intercommunication, exchanging ideas, thoughts, knowing new cultures and, above all, sharing academic experiences between participants of this school, already traditional in the University of Prishtina.

- •1. To provide an opportunity for students to attend specific courses that are not part of the curriculum and that fulfil the additional knowledge in their respective field;
- 2. To provide an opportunity for students to get extra credits toward graduation;
- 3. To develop students' academic performances by the best local and international lecturers.

Courses and teachers

14 courses/seminars in various areas of study, such as social science, law, economics, agriculture, mining and metallurgical, technical, arts, medicine, gender, as well as public discussions/panels and other recreational activities will be held during the 21st edition of the International Summer University. Courses will have modern literature (approximately 25 copies per course), which will be available to the students of PISU.

The number of professors will be equal to the number of courses / seminars, one course unit per international teacher and a local teacher (as collaborators).

For professors who are interested in being part of this project, it is necessary to have professional knowledge of the English language (to lecture in English), and high scientific qualifications.

Certificates and ECTS credits

Participants/students, who attend at least 80% of classes and pass exams, will receive ECTS credits through "The Certificate of Prishtina International Summer University 2023". This certificate includes the description of the course, student ECTS credits, and grades.

The certificate declares the name of the participants and will be signed by the visiting professor of PISU and the co-professor. Certificates are designed according to the Bologna standards.

English will be the language of communication in all courses at the Prishtina International Summer University.

Selection

The selection of courses is based on the needs of the respective faculties by the Commission of PISU 2023. Emphasis will be given to the courses that affect the completion and development of professional knowledge depending on the field of study.

For international students, one of the criteria for admission in PISU will be the advanced knowledge of English language as well as the compatibility of the field of study with the selected course.

Due to the large number of applicants, the selection of the local students will be based on the average grade and on the level of English knowledge. An English proficiency test will be conducted by the academic staff of the University of Prishtina.

Public forums/workshops

Public forums, which raise debates over various socio-economic problems of society, will be part of the Summer University. During the Summer University, at least one open forum with students and participants will be organized. Important figureheads from our country will be invited to share their knowledge with students.

Recreational activities

The following recreational activities are planned to be held during the edition of 2023:

- Weekend excursions (2)
- An opening and closing dinner for the academic staff, UP and PISU officials
 - An opening and closing party for students of PISU 2023
 - Student Evening
 - Football/Volleyball tournament
 - Other recreational activities

Courses start date: 3 July to 14 July 2023




