

- Verify that the job position matches your interests;
- Convince the employer/recruiter you are the right guy for the job.



In conclusion

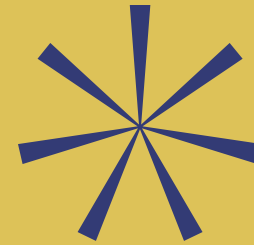
- ✓ Discover your innate strengths.
